TO NEW RESIDENTS - WELCOME TO THE CITY OF IDAHO CITY

The City of Idaho City would like to welcome you and your family to Idaho City. This is a list of resources our community has to offer.

City Council meets the 2nd & 4th Wednesday of every month at City Hall, 511 Main St. 6:00 pm Parks & Recreation Commission meets 3rd Monday of every month at City Hall, 7:00 pm Historic Preservation meets 3rd Wednesday of every month at City Hall, 6:00 pm. Planning and Zoning meets 2nd Monday of every month at City Hall, 6:00 pm.

The Chamber of Commerce and the Boise Basin Interpretive Center (BBIA) are both located in the Visitor's Center, Hwy 21 & Main St.

The City of Idaho City would like to let you know that the City has building codes and requires building permits; these can be picked up at City Hall. The building code is there for your protection, and this includes the Idaho City Historic Preservation Commission (ICHPC) codes within the city. If you live in the Historic District of Idaho City, you will need to contact the ICHPC for the rules governing that district. Building permits are based on International Building Code (IBC) and International Residential Codes (IRC); and fees will be determined by the building inspector.

The City has a nuisance ordinance prohibiting the accumulation of rubbish and garbage on owner/rental property.

A violation of any city ordinance is a misdemeanor or infraction and is punishable accordingly.

The City requires all dogs beyond six-months of age to be licensed; if you have three or more dogs you will be required to have a kennel license. All licenses can be obtained at City Hall. There is a code that requires animals to be in the control of the owner at all times. You could be issued a citation if your animal is running at large.

Dog License (spayed or neutered) \$11.00 per yr. Dog License (non-spayed or neutered) \$27.50 per yr. All animal licenses are on a calendar year and expire on December 31st; if not renewed by January 31st penalties may apply.

The City requires Business and Vendor Licenses; also any other public events require a license. These can be obtained at City Hall. You must have State and County licenses prior to cities approval of said license which must include Assumed Business Name, physical and mailing address, telephone number, State and Federal Tax Identification number.
